When the table is unstable or tilting, you can adjust the leveling feet to fix it.

1. Locate the adjustable leveling feet at the bottom of the table.
2. Loosen the feet on the higher side or tighten the feet on the lower side.
Use a wrench or manually rotate the feet to gradually adjust the height.
3. After adjustment, gently shake the table to ensure it is stable and wobble-free.
If necessary, repeat the steps for fine-tuning.
